NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED DRAWINGS AND SPECIFICATIONS, PROPOSED FORM OF CONTRACT, AND ENGINEER'S OPINION OF PROBABLE CONSTRUCTION COST FOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS – CLEARFIELD AND PRESCOTT – SOUTHERN IOWA RURAL WATER ASSOCIATION – 2018, CRESTON, IOWA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS OWNER – DIVISION 1: ELEVATED STORAGE TANKS – DIVISION 2: PUMP STATIONS AND SCADA BUILDING – DIVISION 3: CLEARFIELD WATER PIPING IMPROVEMENTS – DIVISION 4: PRESCOTT WATER PIPING IMPROVEMENTS – DIVISION 5: ELEVATED STORAGE TANK DEMOLITION – DIVISION 6: PIPING IMPROVEMENTS – ADAIR COUNTY .

Notice is hereby given that there are on file at the office of the Southern Iowa Rural Water Association, Creston, Iowa, whose principal office is located one (1) mile west of the City of Creston in Union County, Iowa, proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated costs for the construction of the Water System Improvements – Clearfield and Prescott – Southern Iowa Rural Water Association – Division 1: Elevated Storage Tanks – Division 2: Pump Stations and SCADA Building – Division 3: Clearfield Water Piping Improvements – Division 4: Prescott Water Piping Improvements – Division 5: Elevated Storage Tank Demolition – Division 6: Piping Improvements – Adair County.

Notice is hereby given that a hearing will be conducted at a public meeting of said Southern Iowa Rural Water Association to be held at the Southern Iowa Rural Water Association Office, located at 1391 190th Street, Creston, Iowa, at **10:00 o'clock A.M.**, on the **18th** day of **April 2018**, at which time and place any person may appear and file objections to the proposed plans, specifications and form of contract and estimated costs for said public improvements.

The location and description of the Work involved is generally as follows:

DIVISION 1: Elevated Storage Tanks: Work is to be located southwest of the intersection of 160th Street and Yellowstone Avenue in the City of Clearfield, Iowa, and northeast of the intersection of 7th Avenue and Poplar Avenue in the City of Prescott, Iowa; the Work is proposed to include furnishing and installing a 200,000 gallon elevated water storage tank, 131 feet to High Water Level in Clearfield, Iowa, and furnishing and installing a 50,000 gallon elevated water storage tank, 188 feet to High Water Level in Prescott, Iowa.

DIVISION 2: Pump Stations and SCADA Building: Work is to be located southwest of the intersection of 160th Street and Yellowstone Avenue in the City of Clearfield, Iowa, east of the

intersection of 1st Street and 7th Avenue in the City of Prescott, Iowa and northeast of the intersection of 7th Avenue and Poplar Avenue in the City of Prescott, Iowa; the Work is proposed to include furnishing and installing Pump Station Improvements at the existing pumping facilities in Clearfield, Iowa, furnishing and installing a new above ground Pump Station in Prescott, Iowa, and furnishing and installing a new above ground SCADA Building in Prescott, Iowa.

DIVISION 3: Clearfield Water Piping Improvements: Work is to be located in the City of Clearfield, Iowa, and in rural portions of eastern Taylor County and western Ringgold County Iowa; the Work is proposed to include furnishing and installing up to approximately 14 miles of 2-inch through 10-inch diameter water distribution piping and water metering.

DIVISION 4: Prescott Water Piping Improvements: Work is to be located in the City of Prescott, Iowa, and in eastern Adams County Iowa; the Work is proposed to include furnishing and installing up to approximately 3 miles of 2-inch through 8-inch diameter water distribution piping.

DIVISION 5: Elevated Storage Tank Demolition: Work is to be located northeast of the intersection of 4th Street and Broadway Street in the City of Clearfield, Iowa, and northwest of the intersection of 6th Street and 8th Avenue in the City of Prescott, Iowa; the Work is proposed to include demolition of a 50,000 gallon elevated water storage tank in Clearfield, Iowa, and demolition of a 50,000 gallon elevated water storage tank in Prescott, Iowa.

DIVISION 6: Piping Improvements – Adair County: Work is to be located in north central and eastern Adair County Iowa; the Work is proposed to include furnishing and installing up to approximately 24 miles of 2-inch through 6-inch diameter water distribution piping.
